



## Rules and submissions to the 2nd edition of the Luis Toharia Grants for Young Researchers in Labor Economics

**SPONSOR: ECONOMICS DEPARTMENT - UNIVERSITY OF ALCALÁ AND URRUTIA ELEJALDE FOUNDATION**

In 2015 there will be 4 grants for young researchers in labor economics that participate in the *XI Jornadas de Economía Laboral*. These grants consist on 250 € plus the exemption of the conference registration fee (the fee is returned ex-post).

### **Eligibility:**

Applicants must take part in the *XI Jornadas de Economía Laboral* and be either pursuing a PhD or be recent PhD graduates (defended her PhD no longer than 2 years ago). They need not to be members of the AEET.

### **Criteria:**

The AEET executive board will appoint a Grant Committee which will evaluate the applications before **June 17, 2015** according the following criteria:

- Relevance of the topic of the paper presented by the candidate in the XI JEL in the field of labour economics.
- Methodological and scientific quality of the paper.
- Priority will be given to youths who are pursuing their PhD.
- Priority will also be given to those not previously benefitted from a Luis Toharia Grant.

The Grant Committee may leave the grants void. The decisions taken by the Grant Committee are not subject to appeal.

### **Documentation:**

Applicants must fill in the on-line form located in the AEET's web page before **May 17, 2015**, and will upload the following documents:

- The paper accepted by the Scientific Committee to be presented in the XI JEL (a single file either in "doc" or "pdf" formats).
- A scanned copy of the personal ID / passport.
- A brief CV (only one page long).
- A copy of the bank transfer receipt proving that the applicant is registered in JEL.
- A document stating that the applicant is pursuing a PhD or has defended her PhD no longer than 2 years ago.

The Award Ceremony of the 2nd edition of the Luis Toharia Grants will take place during the Gala Dinner of XI JEL conference, together with the VII Lluís Fina Prize Award Ceremony. The grants will be effectively delivered upon presentation by the awardees of a copy of the certificate of attendance and presentation of their paper, together with proof of traveling expenses (tickets/invoices).
